LONDON SUMMER PROGRAM 2010

Georgetown Law presents an exciting opportunity to study law this summer in London. The London Summer Program, lasting 4½ weeks, offers six 3-credit courses taught by distinguished faculty from the United States and global scholars associated with the new Center for Transnational Legal Studies.

The summer program, organized in cooperation with King's College London, will include a speaker series and visits to legal landmarks such as the Royal Courts of Justice, the Central Criminal Court, and The Inns of Court. Looking more broadly, London offers countless additional experiences. One of the world's most cosmopolitan cities, it is an ideal location for study abroad and easily accessible to other major European cities by train or plane.

Tuition, housing, & fees: Tuition is \$4,500 for up to 6 credits (all courses are 3 credits). The application fee is \$40, and there is an activities and administrative fee of \$300. Housing is available.

Admission requirements: Completion of 1 year of law study. Good academic standing at an ABA /AALS-accredited law school or foreign law school.

Deadlines: Applications will be accepted beginning in January. Admission is rolling, so early application is recommended. The application deadline is **April 1, 2010.**
